Check the calendar each week to discover the next WAC destination—and don't miss the adventure!

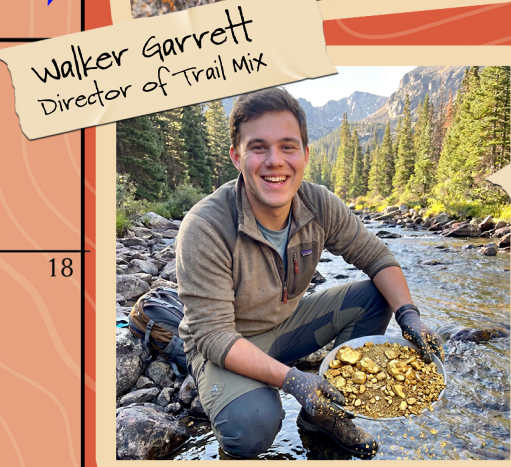

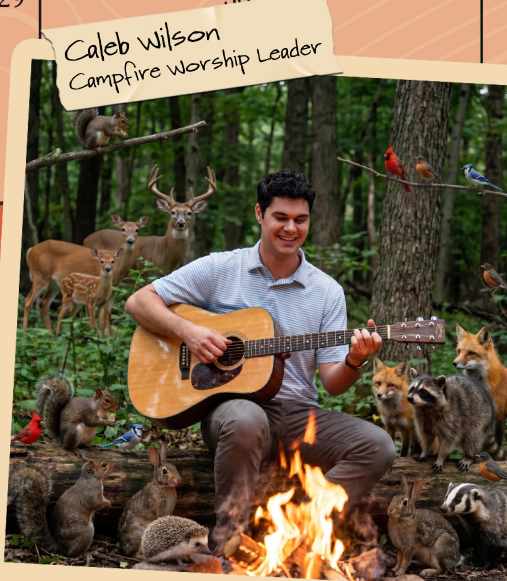
