Serving the Rohingya People Group

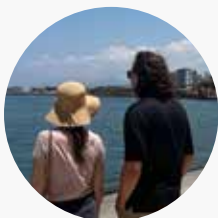
The Rohingya people have been forcibly removed from their home country and now live in the world's largest refugee camp in Bangladesh. The Rohingya are primarily Muslim, with only a tiny minority (less than 1%) of the population identifying as Christian. They are considered one of the most persecuted people groups in the world. We adopted this people group in 2023 to support the work of sharing the Gospel and new church plants.
